RESOLUTION 2016-17 # 36

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board of the Saugus Union School District hereby determines that the following classified positions be reduced and/or abolished for lack of work or lack of funds:

Twenty-six (26) positions that are being reduced in hours:

- (2) Bilingual Instructional Assistant
- (1) Instructional Specialist Music
- (1) Instructional Specialist Computer
- (16) Instructional Assistant
- (6) Library Media Specialist

The one (1) position being laid off are:

- (1) Instructional Specialist Music

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Governing Board as follows:

1. That due to lack of funds or lack of work, the number of classified employees and the amount of service rendered shall be reduced by layoff as specified above, pursuant to Education Code Section 45308.
2. That the Superintendent shall give notice of reduction and/or layoff to the affected classified employees pursuant to the requirements of law, and notify such employees of any displacement rights.
3. That said reduction and/or layoff shall become effective on June 30, 2017 subject to negotiations to the extent required by law.

4. That employees laid off pursuant to this Resolution shall be eligible for reemployment pursuant to Education Code Section 45298.
